Further to Sections 7.3.6 and 7.3.11 of Chapter A of the Partnership's periodic report for 2021, as released on March 24, 2022 (Reference No.: 2022-01-033988), Section 4 of the update to the Partnership's Business chapter included in the Partnership's Q1/2022 report, as released on May 23, 2022 (Reference No.: 2022-01-062278), and Section 4 of the update to the Partnership's Business chapter included in the Partnership's Q2/2022 report, as released on August 18, 2022 (Reference No.: 2022-01-104980), regarding the planned work plan for the Aphrodite reservoir within the area of Block 12 in the exclusive economic zone of the Republic of Cyprus ("Block 12"), and further to the immediate report released by the Partnership on September 18, 2022 (Reference No.: 2022-01-118267), with respect to the approval of a budget for drilling the A-3 well in Block 12 (the "Well"), the Partnership hereby respectfully reports that today it received an amendment to the Production Sharing Contract (PSC), which was signed on November 9, 2022, according to which the date of the obligation of the partners in Block 12 to drill and complete the Well has been extended by 9 additional months, i.e., until August 2023.
