Re: Update on the Aphrodite Reservoir

Further to Sections 7.3.3, 7.3.6 and 7.3.11 of the Partnership's periodic report for 2022, as released on 28 March 2023 (Ref. no.: 2023-01-033096), and Section 5 of the update to Chapter A of the Partnership's Q3/2023 report, as released on 16 November 2023 (Ref. no: 2023-01-104080), regarding the Cypriot government's decision to deny the request of the partners in the Aphrodite reservoir in the area of the EEZ of the Republic of Cyprus (the "**Aphrodite Reservoir**" and the "**Partners**", respectively), for approval of changes to the development and production plan that was approved on 7 November 2019 (the "**Approved Plan**")¹, the Partnership respectfully reports that on 20 November 2023, Chevron Cyprus Limited, the operator in the Aphrodite Reservoir (the "**Operator**") received a letter from the Minister of Energy in the Cypriot government according to which, the Partners were given a seven days extension, until 27 November 2023, to approve their consent to the Approved Plan.

The operator intends to continue its efforts to reach agreements with representatives of the Cypriot government with respect to the reservoir's development plan.
