Re: Granting of a Class Certification Motion

Further to Section 7.27.5 of the Partnership’s 2025 periodic report, as released on 16 March 2026 (Ref. 2026-01-022818), regarding a class certification motion filed by a holder of participation units of the Partnership (the “**Petitioner**”) with the Tel Aviv District Court (Economic Department) against the Partnership, the General Partner, Delek Group Ltd., Yitzhak Sharon (Tshuva), the General Partner’s directors, including the former Chairman of the Board, and the General Partner’s CEO (jointly: the “**Respondents**”), on the grounds that the Respondents refrained from disclosing in the Partnership’s reports the existence of a provision in the agreements for the sale of natural gas from the Leviathan and Tamar reservoirs to Blue Ocean Energy in Egypt (formerly Dolphinus Holdings Limited) (the “**Certification Motion**”), the Partnership respectfully reports that on 10 June 2026, the court’s decision was received, according to which the class certification motion was granted against the Respondents, except against one of the directors whose term of office began at a date later than the events contemplated in the Certification Motion, based on causes of action under the Securities Law, 5728-1968, concerning a misleading detail and a lack of disclosure in a periodic report, with the class including any person who purchased participation units of the Partnership starting from 2 October 2019, and who held such participation units until 24 March 2020, except the Respondents or anyone on their behalf (the “**Decision**”).

The court further ruled that the Respondents shall file an answer to the complaint within 45 days, and shall bear the Petitioner’s costs up to this stage.

The Partnership intends to file a motion with the District Court to revisit the Decision.
